USE LEVEL

Fleischmann's Baking Powder has the same CO₂ gas release as the majority of double-acting, bakery and institutional type baking powders. For various types of baked products, use the typical amounts. For very light products you may need 6% or a little more.

INGREDIENTS

Fleischmann's Baking Powder contains sodium acid pyrophosphate, sodium bicarbonate (baking soda), cornstarch, calcium phosphate.

LEAVENING ACTION

Eight per cent of the CO₂ is released at batter temp, and 92% is released with heat.

MINERAL CONTENT

Calcium content is 13.51 mg per .6 g serving, which equals 1% Ca per serving. Sodium content is 231.67 mg per .6 g serving, which equals 9.5% Na per serving.

MOISTURE

The free moisture content is less than 4%.

GAS RELEASE

All the CO₂ present is available for leavening and typically is more than 14% of the baking powder. For analysis methods, see Methods 923.02 of the Official Methods of Analysis of the Association of Official Analytical Chemists, 17th Edition, 1st Revision, 2002. This baking powder meets the Federal Specifications of the U.S. General Services Administration for Type III baking powder.

LABELING

May be listed as "baking powder" or "leavening," followed by the ingredients.

STORAGE

Product will be stable for up to one year if stored in a cool, dry place and kept tightly closed. Heat and moisture are harmful and should be avoided.

FEDERAL SPECIFICATIONS

Fleischmann's Baking Powder meets the EE-B-25d, 1977 issue, for Type III (orthophosphate and pyrophosphate) baking powder. This specification requires a minimum of 12% available CO₂. Fleischmann's Baking Powder contains 14% or more.
